Let me share some additional information about the project. The proposed CMP corridor would require cutting a new fifty-three mile long corridor through forests in Western Maine. The corridor would be 300-feet-wide and would deliver electricity generated by Hydro-Quebec to customers in Massachusetts. Proponents claim the project would create jobs, benefit Maine communities, and help protect the environment, while opponents claim the project would damage Maine's environment, harm renewable energy companies, and primarily benefit residents of Massachusetts.
